
GGGI is a treaty-based intergovernmental organisation dedicated to supporting and promoting *Climate Resilience* and *Green Growth* in developing and emerging economies

Tonga partnership with GGGI

- Tonga became the 29th GGGI member country in December 2018 and host country agreement was signed in 2020
- GGGI operations in Tonga started in 2019, with Program Officer hired in 2020 and expected to be in country June 2021
- Program for 2019-2020 addressed critical development challenges:
 - Increase electricity generation from renewable sources
 - Strengthen resilience to climate change and natural disasters
- Program for 2021+ to build on previous years' programs and implement:
 - Strengthen policy, planning and regulatory frameworks
 - Investment planning in support of TERM-PLUS 2021-2035
 - Investment planning in support of NDC Targets
 - Mobilize investment in support of Low-Emissions climate resilient development

2020 Tonga Program Achievements

- Review of the 2010-2020 Tonga Energy Road Map (TERM) Recommendations
- Development of the TERM-PLUS Framework
- Review of the NDC and Recommendations Report
- Development of 2020 Enhanced NDC, endorsement by Cabinet with submission and acceptance to the UNFCCC

- Development of TERM-PLUS 2021-2035
- Investment Plan Development for TERM-PLUS 2021-2035
- Development of an NDC Implementation Roadmap
- Investment Plan for NDC Targets of AFOLU, Waste and Marine Protected Areas
- Tonga LT-LEDS completed in an inclusive and participatory manner, endorsed by Cabinet and submitted to UNFCCC before COP26
- MRV strengthening and NDC Mainstreaming supported
